Whales and Dolphins:

There are 2 kinds of whales, toothed whales and baleen whales. Toothed whales eat fish, squid, and sometimes even other marine mammals. Baleen whales use <u>baleen</u>, a material in their mouths, to strain out small shrimp like plankton from the ocean for food.

This type of whale eats tiny organisms that it filters from the mud on the ocean floor.
